

# FOLIAGE TRAY CHARCUTERIE BOARD

Paint a simple but cute charcuterie board.



## MATERIALS

DB32938 Entertaining Serving Platter

> #6 Round Brush #1 Long Liner Brush Pencil Tissue Paper Water-Based Marker

#### COLORS

CMM68 - Beachcomber CMM3 - Carnation CMM29 - Grasshopper CMM14 - Gum Drop CMM31 - Licorice

### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Wipe a damp sponge over the entire plate to remove dust and contaminants.
- 2. Lightly pencil abstract shapes for the background colors.
- 3. Paint 3 coats of Beachcomber and Carnation on the overlapping abstract shapes. Apply the lighter color and let dry, then apply the darker color.
- 4. Let the background dry until the colors look chalky and have completely lost the shine.
- 5. While the background is drying, trace the leafy patterns onto the tissue paper with a pencil.
- 6. Place the tissue paper over the pottery and trace over the pencil lines with a dark water-based marker. Hold onto the tissue carefully so that the design doesn't shift as you trace.
- 7. Paint 3 coats of Grasshopper on the leaves and let dry.
- 8. With a liner brush, add details with 3 coats of Gum Drop.
- 9. With a liner brush, make Licorice accent dashes as accents to fill in space around your designs.
- 10. Using the back of the pencil like a stamp, add Licorice dots around the outside edge of the platter.

#### TIPS

- Allow paint to dry between coats.
- Wash brush between colors.
- Use a contrasted colored marker to make the pattern more visible as you are painting.
- Use masking tape to hold the tissue paper while you are tracing if it shifts.
